## Compound Sentences and Comma Splices

## A COMPOUND SENTENCE CONTAINS:

- Two or more $\qquad$ clauses that are joined by a $\qquad$ and a $\qquad$ conjunction (a FANBOY).
- MAY contain any number of $\qquad$
- CANNOT contain $\qquad$

- The costume frightened the little boy so he ran off screaming.

## A COMMA SPLICE IS:

- When two $\qquad$

- How to fix it:
- Place a period and $\qquad$
